

## Sample Growth Targets

### SAMPLE #1

Taking into account student's entry level of skill, all students will meet their target scores on the final assessment:

Pre-assessment Baseline Score Range	Target Score Range on Post-assessment
41-60	<b>70 or increase score by 15 points, whichever is greater</b>
61-80	<b>85 or increase score by 15 points, whichever is greater</b>
81-90	<b>92 or increase score by 5 points, whichever is greater</b>

### SAMPLE #2

Pre-assessment Baseline Score Range Correct out of 55 total points	Target Score on Post-assessment
0-13	<b>Increase score by 22 points</b>
14-19	<b>Increase score by 16 points</b>
20-24	<b>Increase score by 16 points</b>
25-30	<b>Increase score by 11 points</b>
31-38	<b>Increase score by 5 points</b>

### SAMPLE #3

Students will increase their scores by half the difference between 100 and their pre-assessment score.

For example, a student with a pre-assessment of 50 would be expected to increase his or her score by 25 points on the post-assessment.

$$100 - 50 = 50/2 = 25$$
