SLO Reporting Results: Part 3 in MyLearning Plan

- Are we to report our rating by averaging both SLO percentages together?

Each SLO will have a numerical rating. Combining the SLO results together to obtain an average is not appropriate for this part of the process.

- Can you remind me of the ratings again?

SLO Scoring Matrix

Percentage of students that met or exceeded growth target	Descriptive Rating	Numerical Rating
90-100	Most Effective	5
80-89	Above Average	4
70-79	Average	3
60-69	Approaching Average	2
59 or less	Least Effective	1

Example:

1. Complete final assessment for each of your SLOs.
2. EACH SLO should have a percentage of students who achieved their SGM goal.
3. SLO #1 had 73% of students achieve their goal and SLO #2 had 84% of students achieve their goal.
4. This would give you a '3' for SLO #1 and a '4' for SLO #2.
5. Each SLO is worth 15% of your 50% SGM rating for a total of 30%.
6. The other 20% is automatically a '4' because it is tied to the performance index of the district which is in the 80s.
7. You do not have to worry about the average of your SLOs since this is completed on administrative end when your numbers are entered into eTPES.
